

Key Points for Parents of Aspiring College Athletes

Understanding the College Athletic Landscape

1. Know the Levels of College Sports

- NCAA Division I, II, III
- NAIA (National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics)
- NJCAA (Junior Colleges/Community Colleges)
- Post-Grad (PG programs)

2. Evaluate the Realistic Fit

- Realistically assess athletic skill, academic standing, and personal goals.
- *Recruiting Arena offers in-depth information on academics and athletics for nearly every college, empowering student-athletes to identify and connect with coaches who best align with their goals.*

Timeline & Recruiting Process

3. Start Early

- Begin as early as possible. Even 7th and 8th grade is a great place to start.
- Develop highlight videos and an athletic resume (Arena profile).
- *Start connecting with college coaches early. Recruiting Arena is actively engaging every coach, in every sport, at every college across the nation—giving you unmatched access and opportunity.*

4. Know the Recruiting Calendar

- NCAA rules dictate coach communication timelines.
- Learn about contact, quiet, and dead periods.

5. Attend Camps, Showcases, and Tournaments

- Gain exposure and performance feedback.
- *Use ArenaMail to message coaches working the camps you're attending—introduce yourself and express your interest in connecting at the event.*

Academics & Eligibility

6. Meet NCAA Academic Requirements

- Register with the NCAA Eligibility Center as early as possible.
- Ensure required core courses, GPA, and test scores are met.

7. Maintain Strong Grades

- Coaches prioritize academically eligible athletes.
- *Keep your Arena Profile up to date with all academic and athletic changes—your updates will automatically appear in the Arena Watchlist for every coach following you.*

Communication & Promotion

8. Reach Out to Coaches: 99% of All High School Athletes Will NOT be Discovered!

- **Initiate contact through ArenaMail to express your interest!**
- **College coaches prioritize athletes who show initiative, drive, and a strong desire to compete at the next level.**

9. Build a Recruiting Profile

- Use the Recruiting Arena's free profile. Update frequently!
- Include stats, GPA, videos, and contact info.
- *Every time you update your profile, it automatically refreshes in the Watchlists of all coaches following you.*

10. Keep Communication Professional

- Athletes should lead communication; parents support from the side.

11. Understand Athletic Scholarships

- Not all sports and divisions offer full scholarships; know the difference.

- Look into merit, academic, and need-based financial aid.

13. Plan Unofficial & Official Visits

- Unofficial: anytime, self-funded.
- Official: school-paid, allowed under NCAA guidelines.

14. Evaluate the School Holistically

- Consider academics, distance, team dynamics, and facilities.

Decision & Commitment

15. Understand Verbal Commitments

- Non-binding with no roster spot or scholarship guarantee until a written offer of athletic aid is signed.

16. Review the Written Offer of Athletic Aid *(previously a National Letter of Intent)*

- Used by D1 & D2 schools to formalize commitments.

Why a Coach Might Not Be Interested

Even strong athletes may not receive interest from certain programs. Possible reasons include:

- Roster spots already filled or class full
- Program emphasis on other positions or needs
- Academic mismatch
- Budget or scholarship limitations
- Preference for athletes from a specific region or pipeline
- Athlete's level of play not aligning with the program
- Lack of exposure or timing of contact

Don't take it personally or dwell on one school. Recruiting Arena helps athletes stay focused by tracking outreach, feedback, and status across dozens of programs—helping you pivot quickly and keep momentum going.
